





Research Interviewer positions within the MULTIREP project (ca. 25 interviews and interview training)

Overview:

The positions are offered within the MULTIREP project led by Assoz. Prof. Christopher Wratil (personal website).

The MULTIREP Qualitative Interviewing Study aims to expand our understanding of political representation exploring which aspects of representation citizens care about through online one-to-one interviews and focus groups with citizens in five different countries. Ultimately, the study seeks to provide a more complete picture of what it means for citizens to feel represented. It is part of a multiannual research project involving other research streams. A description of the full project can be found here. Research interviewers will conduct a set of online interviews and focus groups with citizens in the interviewer's native language. They will also attend training prior to conducting the interviews.

Job description:

- Work closely with a team of researchers in the MULTIREP project (e.g. other research assistants, PhD, postdoc, principal and co-investigators)
- Attend training on qualitative interviewing offered to all team members
- Perform data collection through online interviews (focus groups and in-depth interviews) for the research team in one of the five countries covered by the study
- Support the logistics of the online interviewing study in one of five countries (e.g. check invitation texts, collect and store data on university servers)
- Period: From December 2023 to early summer 2024
- Contract: Works contract
- <u>Salary:</u> Competitive
- Benefits: flexible working hours, home office arrangements

Your profile:

- Required: Native language skills in Danish, Dutch, French, or "American English"
- Studying a bachelor or masters in a social science discipline (incl. economics)
- Excellent marks in your studies so far
- Experience in interviewing or willingness to learn qualitative interviewing techniques

- Ability to coordinate with a team, high reliability, attention to detail and data security, eagerness to learn, pro-active attitude, willingness to work on weekends or late afternoons
- Very good command of English for teamwork (knowledge of German is <u>not</u> necessary)
- *Desirable*: Interest in political representation, political attitudes of citizens, or politicians' communication activities.

Application

Applications should consist of:

- **Short cover letter** (presenting your experience in or motivation to learn and practice qualitative interviewing, max. half a page)
- Curriculum vitae
- Transcripts of record from your bachelor and (where applicable) master's studies
